Position Overview:

The key focus of this role is to serve as a 'Tourism Information Officer' for the Labrador Straits Region, to provide information and welcome residents, travelers, tourists, and visitors, travelling aboard the Strait of Belle Isle Ferry and at the Gateway to Labrador Visitor Centre.

Responsibilities:

- Greet and welcome locals, newcomers, travelers, tourists, and visitors on the ferry.
- Engage in promoting and providing insights into the attractions and features of the Labrador Straits region.
- Participate in the in-house training program.
- Work with LSHDC staff to identify additional opportunities to enrich tourism activities around our heritage resources, and to help organize and promote to local communities.
- Share information about:
